JIA JUANLI

JIA JUAN LI is one of the most talented Chinese artists of her generation. Exhibited in Paris at the Grand Palais, on the Champs Elysees during the FIAC and at the Chinese Cultural Center. Medals in Monte Carlo and Le Louvre.



QINGMEI YAO

Qingmei Yao is a young multidisciplinary artist, a graduate of the National School of the Villa Arson in Nice. Her concerns revolve around a political questioning, through performance, video and photography.



YINING ZHAO

Yining Zhao graduated from the Institute of Photographic Arts in Sichuan, and hold a MA from the University of Lyon. She worked for the Abode of Chaos near Lyon, extraordinary exhibitions domain hosted by Thierry Ehrmann, founder of Artprice.



Saturday Septembre 10th at 5:00 pm: Collégiale Saint-Lazare - Concert WANG SHENG

A concert will follow in the afternoon. Wang Sheng will play Nocturnes of Chopin, Debussy Suites and a piece of a Chinese composer. He studied piano at the Conservatory of Shanghai, then to the Regional Conservatory of Paris and finally at the prestigious Ecole Normale de Musique de Paris Alfred Cortot.



In the afternoon, a inititiation to Chinese ideograms and music, and a wine tasting will be offered. A thematic dinner will follow the concert, led by renowed chef Marc Meneau who is opening a gourmet restaurant in Shanghai.

Sunday September 11th at 2:30 pm: Avallon Museum VISIT OF THE COLLECTION YAO, MIEN ET MUN

A presentation will be held of the exceptional Yao, Mien and Mun collection, in China, Vietnam, Laos and Thailand. This is the most complete and largest collection of Taoist documents, of costumes and jewelry from these ethno-linguistic minorities originated in China.



The Avallon Chinese Art Festival will be one of the first festivals devoted to China in France. It will bring together many institutional personalities interested in the relations between our two countries and their companies.
